Private George Armstrong, Scottish Rifles, Canonbie, died on the 7th inst from diphtheria in hospital. He was wounded last year, and was the eldest son of Mr John Armstrong, merchant, Roadend, Canonbie. He was 19 years of age.

On Sunday morning the parents of Miss Eleanor Teresa Armstrong were officially informed by a letter, dated March 12th, that the terrible injuries inflicted upon their daughter by the bomb outrage at the Pera Palace Hotel, Istanbul, had resulted in her death.

At the time of her death Miss Armstrong was the Assistant Private Secretary of Mr George W Rendell, till recently British Minister in Sofia, the capital of Bulgaria. She was a native of Canonbie, and came with her parents about three years ago to live at 24 Scotland Road, Stanwix. She received her business training at the Carlisle Gregg School, where she made herself very popular, being known to her intimates as "Terry." Her abilities and industry resulted in a short but brilliant career, and after her training in the City Treasurer's Office, she left Carlisle to take up a secretarial appointment. Similar appointments followed, till her success in a competitive examination secured her a post on the staff of the International Labour Office of the League of Nations. Twelve months ago she received her important appointment with Mr Rendell.

In Geneva she stayed with a French family, and spoke their language like a native. She was also a fluent speaker of German, and had some knowledge of Spanish. Horse riding as well as walking was one of her favourite pastimes. Her short leaves – too short to enable her to visit her home in Carlisle – were spent at Athens and other resorts on the Continent, some of her travelling being done by air. When at home she was keen on tramping and climbing in the Lake District. She was thirty years of age. She is survived by her mother, three sisters and a brother, with whom the deepest sympathy is felt.

Father of a Bomb Victim

Mr John Armstrong, aged 71, a retired grocer, of Canonbie, who lived at 24 Scotland Rd, Stanwix, was killed near his home this (Friday) morning. He was crossing the road to his house after purchasing a newspaper at about 8.30, and was knocked down by a double decker bus proceeding North. He received severe injuries, which necessitated his removal to the Infirmary, but on arrival there, life was found to be extinct.

A Recluse's Sad Death - an inquest was held at Longtown, near Carlisle, on Wednesday night, on the body of James Bell, of no occupation, who has lived alone for several years at a house at Longtown, and was killed at a level crossing on the North British Railway near that place on Tuesday, with over £500 in his possession. David Bell, market gardener, Ardrossan, said the deceased was a farm labourer in early life, and went to America, where he made some money. He returned to England eleven years ago. The sudden death took place recently of Dr Andrew William Gardiner at Keighley, Yorkshire, where he was one of the best-known medical men of that town. Dr Gardiner was a native of Dumfriesshire, and a son of ex-Police Sergeant Gardiner (Dumfries County Police) and of the late Mrs Sarah Gardiner, Blackbank, Gretna. He was in his 42nd year. Dr Gardiner received part of his education at Dumfries Academy before entering the University. While at the Academy he was the first pipe-major to be appointed in the Cadet Corps which was formed in 1916, and in that capacity rendered faithful service to the Corps. Dr Gardiner had been in practice in Keighley for ten years. He was medical officer to the Keighley Home Guard, and did a great amount of work for the service.

Mr J B Lee, coroner for East Cumberland, held an inquest on Tuesday at Penton Station on the body of Robert Jardine, foreman surfaceman, aged 52, who was run over by a train and killed on the previous day. It appeared that the deceased, who had been 30 years in the employment of the Company as surfaceman, was with other men lifting the metals and repairing the way about 92 yards west of Penton Station, the day being clear but windy, when a goods train came on the up line. The men stepped aside, and when the train had drawn up to shunt they were returning to work when a fast passenger train came up on the other line and struck the deceased, who was in front of the other men. The goods train was blocking the vision and making a noise; no whistle was heard from the passenger train. John Sloan, the driver of the passenger train from Riccarton, which was going at 40 miles an hour, deposed that he did not see the men until half-way down the platform. He had previously whistled. He saw the deceased the moment before he was run over and at once applied the brake and stopped the train. The jury returned a verdict of accidental death owing to a mistake of the deceased, and handed their fees to the Cumberland Infirmary.
