I have been amazed at the numbers of letters I have received in reference to the paintings of greyhounds, prints of which appear in so many of the local public houses and in the homes of the local sporting fraternity. From what I have gathered, most of them were the work of Armstrong, of Aglionby, a painter of some skill and talent, when he tackled greyhounds, but as a painter of the human subject his work is characterised by lack of life and stiffness, and is altogether amateurish. . .

GRETNA FARMER KILLED The Gretna district has sustained a severe loss by the death in action of Private David G. Bell, K. O. S. B., who before voluntarily joining the army in June of 1916 was a farmer in Raeburnfoot, Gretna. Thirtynine years of age, was young mart of exceptional promise. With high ideals and gifted with cheerful and obliging disposition, he was held in high esteem by a large circle of friends. A skilled agriculturist, he took a prominent part in the social and church life of the district in which he lived. He was a well-known draughts player, and on two occasions was champion of the county. An all-round athlete, he took a great interest in outdoor sports. He was member of the noted Chapelknowe tug-of-war team, which proved their prowess on many occasions, and had an unbeaten record. Mr Bell possessed musical abilities of a high order, and as a baritone singer was much in request at social gatherings. He was also an excellent violinist, and was equally home at the piano and the organ. He was leader of praise in Gretna United Free Church, and for a number of years had acted as one the managers of the church. He was third son of the Mr John Bell, Guards Mill, and Mrs Bell, Raeburnfoot. His position a farmer would have been sufficient to entitle him to exemption, but when the call for men became more pressing in 1916 and married men were taken, he regarded it as a matter of conscience to volunteer, and his services were accepted. He went out to France in the beginning of January 1917, and except for a short time, when he was hospital with trench fever, he was continuously in service until 31st July 1917, when he was reported missing. Since that date nothing has been heard of him, and it has now been concluded, that he was killed at that time. On 15th November 1916 he married Miss May M'Donald, The Hill, Gretna. Deep sympathy will be felt with his young widow, widowed mother, and the other members of the family.

On Saturday last, Mr Richard Birrell, tea dealer, Church-street, aged 30.

On Saturday last, at about half-past two o'clock in the afternoon, a travelling Scotchman named Richard Birrell, from Blackburn who was lodging at the Duke of William, was found dead in his bed. It appears that on the preceding evening he had gone to bed ailing nothing, and as it was customary with him to lie until twelve o'clock on the following day, they were not alarmed at his lying a little longer than usual; but when it had got after two o'clock, they opened his room door and made the awful discovery that he was a corpse. Mr Richardson, surgeon, who was immediately sent for, gave it as his opinion that the deceased died of a fit of apoplexy. The deceased was only thirty years of age. We may just state that his death must have occurred after nine o'clock of the same day, for at that hour Mrs Hornby took him a pair of stockings, and he responded to her questions and seemed in his usual health.

A regrettable accident occurred at Gretna Green on Saturday night to an old man named Gibson, who received such injuries that he died the same night. Gibson, who was 77 years of age, was for many years an engineer at McKinnell's works at Dumfries, but in latter years he has lived in retirement at Gretna Green with his daughter, Mrs Kirkpatrick. On Saturday night he had been in the house of a friend, and at a quarter to eight he left to go home. It was a dark night and he had not gone far when he was struck in front by the shaft of a milk cart, belonging to Mr Ritchie, Waughslee, Canonbie, which was being driven to Gretna Green station by Mr Ritchie, jun. The blow knocked down the unfortunate man, and the wheel of the cart passed over him. He was immediately carried home, a doctor was wired for, and Dr Carruthers soon arrived from Kirkpatrick. All was done for the injured man that was possible, but his ribs had been broken, penetrating the vital organs, and death ensued in about three hours. The deceased had numerous friends in the neighbourhood, and his painful end will be heard of with regret. It is stated that the lamps of the milk cart were burning all right at the time of the accident.

A Signalman's Sad End

Last evening Mr H B Lonsdale, City Coroner, held an inquest at the City Police Office on the body of John Lamb, 61 years of age, a signalman at No. 1 cabin on the Port Carlisle Branch of the Caledonian Railway, whose dead body was

found on the line near his signal box early the same morning by Thomas Wright, foreman platelayer, Willow Holme. For about 33 years Lamb had been signalman at Gretna, but two months ago he was transferred to Carlisle, and resided in Scaurbank Road, Stanwix. On Sundays his signal cabin, which is near the bacteria beds, is not in use, but on Monday morning Lamb had to be on duty about 6.30. He had gone to his cabin as usual, lighted the cabin lamps, when it is supposed that he must have been knocked down and run over by the 6.35 am passenger train from Carlisle to Longtown. When discovered both feet were found to have been severed from the body, and other injuries inflicted as well. The body was afterwards removed to the mortuary on the West Walls.

At the inquest, James Lamb, railway guard, Maryhill, Glasgow, son of the deceased, gave evidence of identification. Thomas Wright, platelayer, who is very deaf, stated that the body was on the down line opposite the signal cabin when he found it. Thomas Wylie, Caledonian Buildings, another platelayer, and John Hope, Newtown, the driver of the North British train, having also given evidence, it was shown that there were no marks visible on the engine of the train when examined at Longtown. The jury found that the deceased had been accidentally killed while in the execution of his duty.

December 29th 1908 Carlisle Journal SHOCKING FATALITY NEAR ETTERBY

Late on Thursday night, John Lamb, aged 34, unmarried, of 5, Etterby Road, Stanwix, a brakesman on the railway, was killed on the Caledonian Railway near No. 3 cabin, Willow Holme, by the express from Glasgow due in the Citadel Station at 11.28. He was walking along the line at the time on his way home. His body was removed to the Mortuary, West Walls, to await an inquest. By a strange coincidence it transpires that the dead man's father was similarly killed on the railway a few years ago at almost exactly the same spot.

The inquest was held at the Police Office on Saturday before Mr H B Lonsdale, the City Coroner. Evidence of identification was given by Albert Lamb, deceased's brother, who said the deceased left home at seven o'clock on Thursday evening.

John Weir, Eden Crescent, Edentown, signalman at No 3 cabin, said he heard a thud after the Caledonian Express had crossed the bridge over the Caldew about half-past eleven. Thinking something was wrong, he went and examined the line and found the deceased... (Verdict: accidental death).

THE LAST OF THE GRETNA PRIESTS

The last of the Gretna priests is dead - old Simon Lang - who for many years past has been the lone survivor of a long line of self-appointed dignitaries. He died on the 24th of April at Felling, near Newcastle-on-Tyne (at which place he was staying with his son over winter), and was buried in Gretna Churchyard last Friday afternoon. The united careers of the two Langs, father and son, as priests, extend over fully eighty years. David, the father, was born and brought up in the parish of Gretna. Early in life he went into Lancashire as draper or pedlar, and soon afterwards was carried off by the pressgang. During the time he was in the English service, the ship in which he sailed was boarded and taken by Paul Jones, the redoubtable pirate - Paul being among the first men who stepped on beard. The captives were ran into a French port, and inducements made for them to join the American service, in which Paul then served. David Lang, however, returned safe home to Gretna - donned the priest's ceremonials in the year 1792, and continued in the wedding line till the time of his death, nearly forty years after. The greatest achievement of his reign was the marriage of Thomas, Lord Erskine, in his old age, to his mistress, Miss Sarah Buck, of York Buildings, Marylebone. For this event, it is said, he netted the sum of one hundred guineas. David succeeded in joining several scions of noble and powerful houses, including the Villiers, the Beauclercs, the Coventrys, and others of almost equal

standing. He was cut off rather suddenly in 1827, in his 72nd year, from the effects of a severe cold, caught while attending the great sensational trial at Lancaster of Wakefield, for the abduction of Mrs Turner, a rich heiress, 15 years old. After this event, Simon Lang at once entered upon the duties of the priestly office; and as his father's fame was full in the land, he naturally fell into the lucrative branch of business at once. Sim, however, had his trials amongst it all. Some of his rivals, becoming jealous of his success, resorted to all sorts of unprincipled dodges in order to injure and annoy him. If a newly arrived couple wanted to find out 'Lang the priest,' the invariable answer was, "Deid an' buriet, lang sen'!" "But his son - surely he lives?" ask the strangers. "Deid a' —died's a door nail!" is again the response. Yet In spite of such unfair opposition, Sim flourished abundantly, following closely his legitimate occupations of marrying and weaving, and occasionally varying the tone of these by doing a little smuggling on the quiet. He long outlived all his competitors, and saw the decline of the golden days of old Gretna; but still he continued in harness to the last. About twelve months since, he went through probably the last marriage ceremony he ever performed in complete dishabille, having nothing on but his shirt and drawers! The reason of this unwonted exhibition was that the parties reached Gretna from Dumfries by the midnight train, and, like all fond lovers, could brook no delay; so the old priest was aroused from his slumbers to do duty at a moment's notice.
